

The Difference Game

Materials: pack of numeral cards, die

1. Work with a partner. Place nine cards face-up in three rows of three. Put the remaining cards face down in a stack.
2. Take turns to roll a die and look for two cards whose difference equals the number on the die. If you can pick up two cards use the math talk sentence:

The difference between
___ and ___ is ___.

3. If neither player can pick up a pair of cards after they roll the die, turn over one more card from the stack and place it on top of one of the other cards.
4. Keep going until all the cards have been picked up.
