

Add and Compare

Materials: number cubes, Add and Compare board for each player

Number of Players: 2

1. Take turns with a partner to roll two number cubes. After each roll both players must decide in which two boxes on their board to write the numbers rolled. Be strategic! You can place the numbers anywhere on your board but your goal is to have the **largest sum** for each problem.
2. When all boxes are filled players calculate the sum for each problem.
3. Check your partner's work and compare your answers. The player with the largest sum for each problem scores one point. The player with the most points wins the game.
