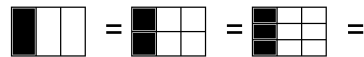
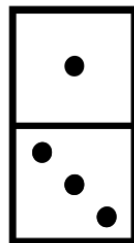


Equivalent Fractions: Dominoes

Materials: dominoes

1. Work with a partner. Choose a domino and position it so that the pips represent a fraction less than one. Record the fraction.
2. Write the next four equivalent fractions in the sequence.
3. Use visual fraction models to explain your reasoning to your partner.
4. Repeat with other dominoes.



$$\frac{1}{3} = \frac{2}{6} = \frac{3}{9} = \frac{4}{12} = \frac{5}{15}$$
