Materials: number cards 0-9 (4 of each), Place Value Challenge recording sheet


1. Deal five cards from the top of the deck to each player.
2. Players use the five cards to make the largest four-digit number possible. Each player must discard one card (put it in the trash).
3. Record your numbers and the number you decided to discard on the recording sheet.
4. Players compare numbers. The player with the largest number for the round scores 1 point.
